Some people watch ice hockey or football in the winter. It's good fun. They do not watch ice hockey in the summer.

Chuck: No, I don't. We don't go to football matches. Markéta doesn't like football. When is the next match?

Jo: It's on Monday. Shall we go to it? Have you got any other free time next week?

Jo: Oh, no, sorry. I haven't got time for lunch on Tuesday. Shall we meet in the evening on Friday, at six o'clock?
