Altogether, nine children are going to the party. Their mothers or fathers are taking them and then fetching them later, so Jo is cutting plenty of bread.

### **Talking in Markéta's kitchen**

**Markéta:** Chuck, Jody and Ellen are shopping. They're getting some more biscuits. Jo, this is my sister-in-law, Hana. Hana, this is Jo.

**Jo:** How do you do, Hana? I'm pleased to meet you.

**Hana:** How do you do, Jo? There is my little boy, Jarek, in the living room.

**Jo:** How old is he?

**Hana:** He's nearly eight. It's his birthday next month. He's blowing up balloons and bursting most of them.

**Jo:** It wouldn't be a children's party without balloons! Markéta, where shall I put this plate of sandwiches?

**Markéta:** Oh, on the dining table, please, with the crisps and the ice cream. Are the glasses and the fruit juice ready?

**Jo:** Yes, they're on a tray. What else shall I do?

**Markéta:** Please would you bring another chair from the bedroom into the living

room? The armchairs and the settee are for the grown-ups, and the children can sit on cushions on the floor – when they're not playing or causing damage!

(The doorbell rings)

**Markéta:** Molly, your guests are arriving! Come and open the door with me. Come on!

**Hana:** Where are you from, Jo?

**Jo:** From Yorkshire, in the north-east of England. I like living in Pilsen now.

Do you live far from here?

**Hana:** Not far at all – my flat is in the next block.

**Jo:** Is your husband coming today?

**Hana:** No, we're divorced.

**Jo:** Oh, I'm sorry. By the way, your dress is a lovely colour. Red suits you.

It's the same colour as Jarek's jumper, too.

**Hana:** Yes, but he likes green, so he's got green trousers on for the party.

Are you living alone in Pilsen?

**Jo:** Yes, I'm single. I'm not married... Your English is very good.

**Hana:** Oh, thanks. Well, I'm working in an international company and we need foreign languages there. I'm studying English in the evenings. My workmates and I are learning French, too. We're getting plenty of practice on the phone, talking to our colleagues abroad.

**Jo:** Is it an interesting job?

**Hana:** Yes, it is. We're developing new IT systems.

**Jo:** That sounds good. Let's go and join the party.

**Hana:** All right. We shouldn't stay in the kitchen, talking!

(Later... the doorbell rings again)

**Chuck:** Hello, Zuzana, hello Katka. That's a pretty yellow dress you're wearing.

Aren't you looking sweet! Do come in.

**Zuzana:** Hello, Chuck. Sorry we're late. I couldn't find the right block of flats.

**Chuck:** Never mind. Let me take your coat. Molly, here's Katka!

(Everybody sings "Happy Birthday")
